Appetizers

Turnip soup 8.50 €

- creamy turnip soup, toasted white bread, butter

Aspic 8.80 €

- traditional aspic, wild mushroom salad, cranberry compote

Main courses

Tavern pike balls 25.50 €

- fishballs made of pike, dill and egg sauce,
roasted beetroots, boiled potatoes

Karelian stew 22.80 €

- stew of beef and pork,
mashed potatoes, roasted local root vegetables

Country sausages 26.50 €

- Tavern kitchen country sausages, mashed potatoes,
lingonberries, pickles, tar mustard

Lamb kidneys 22.80 €

- lamb kidneys in cream sauce, cranberry jelly, barley risotto

Blueberry pie and custard 7.80 €

- rye blueberry pie and vanilla custard
